**BYLAW NO. 5-2019**

**A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No. 137 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No. 137 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) “Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) “Council” shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - c) “Municipality” shall mean the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No. 137.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule A which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
4. Bylaw No. 15-2015 is hereby repealed.

## **SCHEDULE A**

### **Hourly**

- one alarm: the productive rate of coverage for fire suppression/extrication services as set by SGI (1 platoon, 2 trucks)
- two alarm: \$30/additional firefighter

#### **\*max fire call charges (for ratepayers)**

- residential: \$2,500
- commercial: \$5,000

### **Inspection of Properties.**

The cost of fire prevention and life safety inspections shall be charged to the property owner or tenant according to the rates charged to the Municipality by the Municipality's appointed Inspector, which may be revised from time to time.
