



BYLAW NO. 6-1994

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES
PURSUANT TO SECTION 206(2)(c) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No. 137 No. 137 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 40 kilometers per hour on a public highway within the Hamlet of Wymark, including that portion of roadway within the R.M. of Swift Current No. 137 (4th Avenue) located adjacent to and immediately East of the Eastern boundary of the Hamlet of Wymark (East of SE-29-13-13-3) extending from the South boundary of the NE-29-13-13-3 Southward and parallel to the Hamlet of Wymark boundary to the North boundary of First street (Highway #379).
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected on all streets entering the Hamlet and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
