A BYLAW REQUIRING SECURING OF LOADS TRANSPORTING GARBAGE, REFUSE OR RUBBISH

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No.. 137, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

L. DEFINITIONS

for the purpose of this Bylaw:

- (a) "garbage" means putrescible animaland vegetable remains and by-products resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food;
- (b) "refuse" means:
 - i) remains;
 - ii) by-products; and
 - iii) discarded materials;

resulting from domestic, commercial, industrial or agricultural activities and includes garbage, rubbish, street cleanings and yard clippings but does not include liquid domestic sewage;

- c) "rubbish" means non-putrescible remains and by-products, consisting of both combustible and non-combustible remains and by-products, and includes paper, cardboard, tin cans, wood, glass, bedding and crockery;
- d) "public highway" means a road allowance or a road, street, or lane vested in Her Majesty or set aside for such purpose and includes a bridge, culvertdrain or other public improvement erected upon or in connection with such public highway.
- 2. No person shall operate any vehicle transporting garbage, refuse or rubbish over any public highway in the Rural Municiaplity of Swift Current No. 137 unless the load is completely secured in such a manner that it shall be impossible for any part of the load of the said vehicle to escape.

3. A person contravening any provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$ 50.00 and not exceeding \$200.00 and costs
