



BYLAW NO. 9-1995

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES
PURSUANT TO SECTION 206(2)(c) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Swift Current No. 137 No. 137 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 kilometers per hour on a public highway within the Hamlet of Springfield, which shall include that portion of roadway located in the R.M. of Swift Current No. 137, East of Section 5-14-13-3 (approximately 1.6 kms.).
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the North and South ends of the aforementioned Municipal Road entering the Hamlet and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
